

MICHIGAN NEW JOBS TRAINING PROGRAM

The Michigan New Jobs Training Program (MNJTP) is a contract-training reimbursement program developed by the Michigan Community College Association (MCCA) and administered through Michigan community colleges. MNJTP is available to employers that are creating new full-time jobs in the state, and it can provide flexible funding to meet a variety of training and employee development needs. A wide range of training can be covered from highly specialized/customized training to basic skills instruction:

- Adult basic education and job-related instruction
- Developmental, readiness, and remedial education
- Vocational and skill assessment services and testing
- Subcontracted services with public universities and colleges in Michigan, private colleges or universities, or any federal, state, or local departments or agencies
- Contracted professional services
- Training that happens at the company site, delivered by the employer's corporate trainers

Funds to cover the costs of training are attained through a diversion of state withholding taxes generated by the wages of eligible new positions and deposited into a training account at the college.
