Students should seek an appointment with an Academic Advisor to determine courses which best meet individual academic goals and to discuss transfer options including verification of courses towards the completion of the Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA). Students must complete a minimum of 60 credits in approved courses to earn a degree at Kellogg Community College with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or higher. NOTE 1: EMT 110 is a requirement. You may take EMT 110 before or during the academy; however, you will need to pass the National Registry Exam and obtain your Michigan License. It is recommended that you take EMT 110, before the police academy. Contact the Policy Academy Director with questions.

NOTE 2: Transfer credit awarded upon successful completion of Fire Fighter 1 & 2 certification by the State of Michigan, along with admittance into the police academy.

NOTE 3: Radar is an optional course that is available to Academy and In-service Law Enforcement Personnel.

NOTE 4: The 5th Semester is only three weeks long.

NOTE 5: Students may need to meet program admissions guidelines. Refer to the KCC 2020-2021 Academic Catalog for more information or call the Criminal Justice Department at 269-660-7703.
