Early College students should seek an appointment with the Dual Enrollment and Early College Student Success Coach to determine courses which best meet individual academic goals and to discuss transfer options, including verification of courses towards the completion of the Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA). Students must complete a minimum of 60 credits in approved courses to earn a degree at Kellogg Community College with a minimum cumulative grade-point average of 2.0 or higher.

Service-learning endorsement is required! Additional required degree criteria is listed in KCC's Academic Catalog under degree and certificate requirements. Note: Early College students are encouraged to enroll in SERV 200 to meet this requirement.
