Students must complete a minimum of 60 credits in approved courses to earn a degree at Kellogg Community College with a minimum cumulative grade-point average of 2.0 or higher.

Service-learning endorsement is required! Additional required degree criteria is listed in KCC's Academic Catalog under degree and certificate requirements. Note: Early College students are encouraged to enroll in SERV 200 to meet this requirement.
