## **Schedule and Registration**

Year-round calendar viewable	March
Fall registration opens	April
Spring registration opens	October
Summer registration opens	March

## Suggested Timeline

## Notes:

1. It is recommended that all courses are submitted for approval prior to students registering for their courses.

2. All new students will need to complete Learning Technologies Readiness (LTR).

3. Students who are taking summer courses only need to be approved if a) the school is paying and/or b) the student is receiving high school credit for the course.

4. High School transcripts are only needed for students who are enrolling in BIOL 201 (Human Anatomy) or includes the students PSAT/SAT 2-digit scores.
