



BOARD OF TRUSTEES SCHOLARSHIP RESPONSIBILITIES

- Be enrolled as a full-time student (12 credits or more) for the fall and spring semesters. This requirement may be waived if you are accepted to certain KCC academic programs, or in specific situations as approved by the Director of Student Life and the KCC Foundation.
- Maintain a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA while enrolled at KCC.
- Maintain contact each fall and spring semester with the Director of Student Life.
- Follow an approved KCC curriculum (transfer or Associate degree program).
- Adhere to the Student Code of Conduct, as outlined in the Student Handbook.
- Complete the Student Leadership Institute.
 - The *Student Leadership Institute (SLI)* is a multi-week workshop provided in the fall semester under the philosophy that all students possess leadership potential, and that leadership can be enhanced when given the opportunity to develop. The SLI focuses on providing components critical to the development of the leadership talent of KCC students. Students meet once a week.
- Become a member of Phi Theta Kappa, when eligible.
- Complete a service-learning development plan that includes two of the following:
 1. A 15-hour service activity with reflection paper.
 2. Enrollment in Serv 100.
 3. Enrollment in Serv 200.
- Create and maintain a leadership development plan that minimally includes:
 1. One transformative enrichment activity/experience each fall and spring semester, as approved by the Director of Student Life.
 - a) These are activities/experiences you identify, plan and complete every semester. Explore a new skill, grow your understanding of a new concept/culture and expand your critical thinking abilities. Enrichment activities are customized to you, and you will work with the Director of Student Life to outline an appropriate objective that fits your KCC experience.
 2. Leadership responsibilities on campus such as serving in an officer role of a Registered Student Organization or campus committee or leader of a campus activity.
