

IMPORTANT NOTES:

Students should seek an appointment with an Academic Advisor to determine courses which best meet individual academic goals and to discuss transfer options including verification of courses towards the completion of the Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA). Students must complete a minimum of 60 credits in approved courses to earn a degree at Kellogg Community College with a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or higher.
