Early college is when a high school junior begins taking a specific set of college classes while they are still in high school with the goal of earning a degree.

Early college students attend college classes at KCC along with their high school classes through a “fifth year” extending about one year after traditional high school graduation, and receive both a high school diploma and an associate degree when they’re done.
