## KCC Department Highlight

### Athletics

Kellogg Community College is proud to offer nine competitive athletic programs for student-athletes. These include Men's Baseball, Basketball, Cross Country, and Bowling, along with Women's Basketball, Cross Country, Bowling, Soccer, and Volleyball.

Each year, approximately 120 student-athletes represent KCC, continuing their athletic careers while pursuing a college education.

### Bruins on a Roll: Championships & Recognition

#### Baseball Dominance

KCC's baseball team delivered an exceptional spring season, earning back-to-back regional titles and advancing to the NJCAA World Series in Enid, Oklahoma, after an undefeated run in the regional tournament. Eleven team members earned postseason honors from the MCCA and NJCAA, with Head Coach Eric Laskovy recognized as Coach of the Year.

#### Bowling Breakthrough

In March, history was made as KCC's women's bowling team captured the College's first-ever national championship title in women's doubles bowling—a proud moment that highlights the talent and dedication within the Bruins athletic program.

#### Cross Country Champions

Both the men's and women's cross country teams took home NJCAA Region 12 Division III Championship titles in October 2024.

Freshman standout Julian Borst also had a remarkable season, finishing 6th overall at Nationals. He was named an NJCAA All-American, placing as the fourth fastest freshman in the competition.
