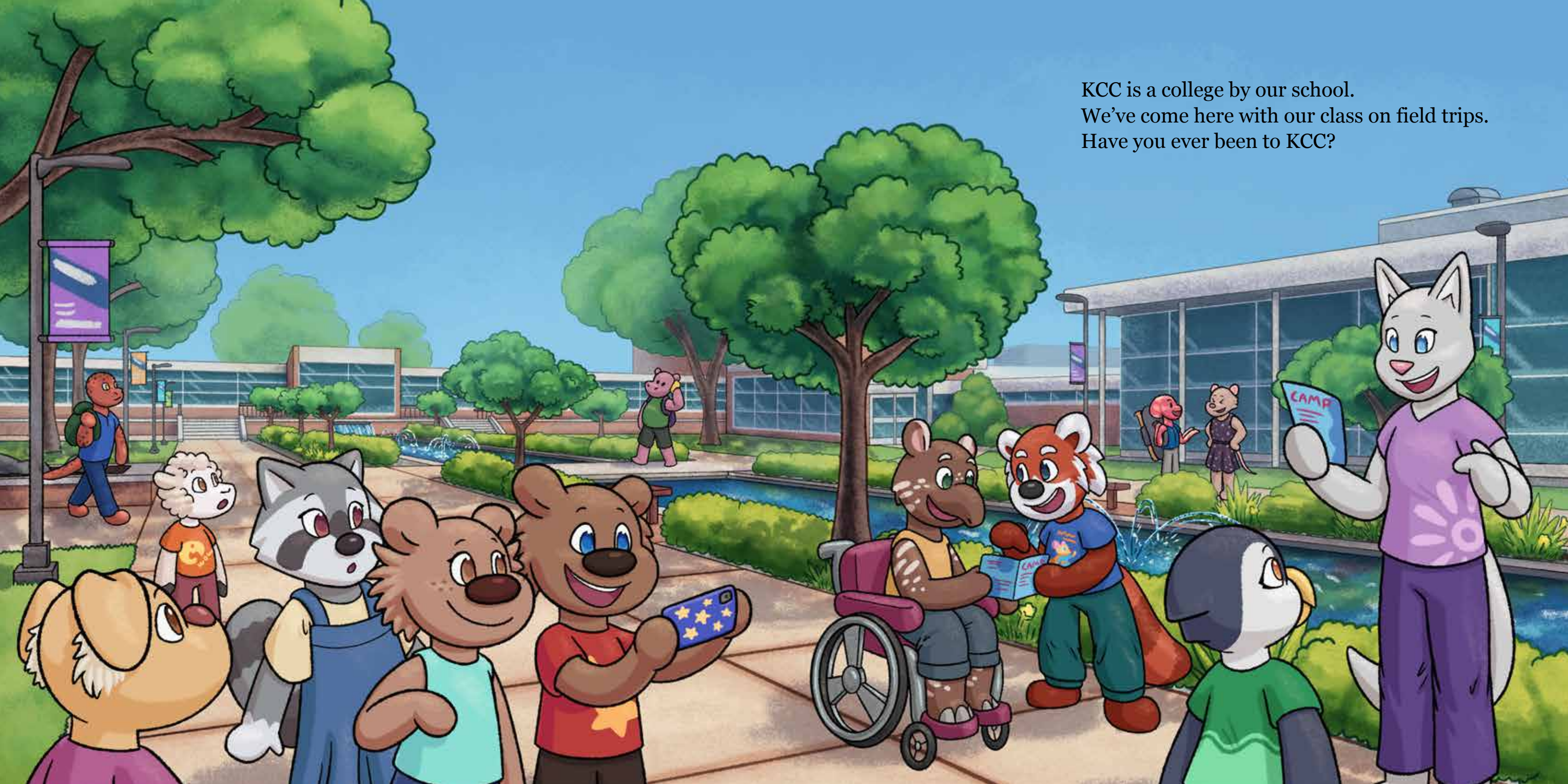

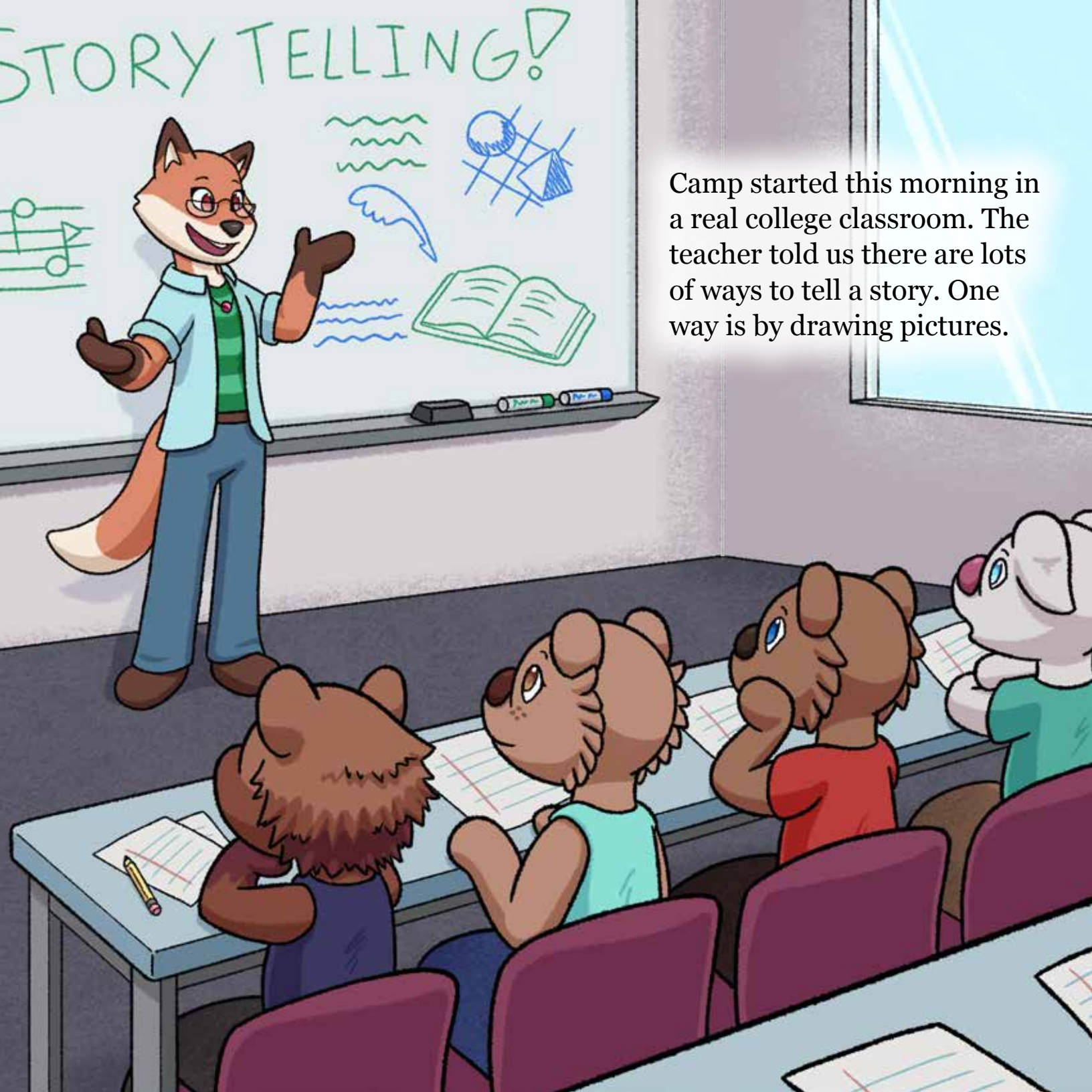

This is Blaze and Bella reporting live from camp at Kellogg Community College!





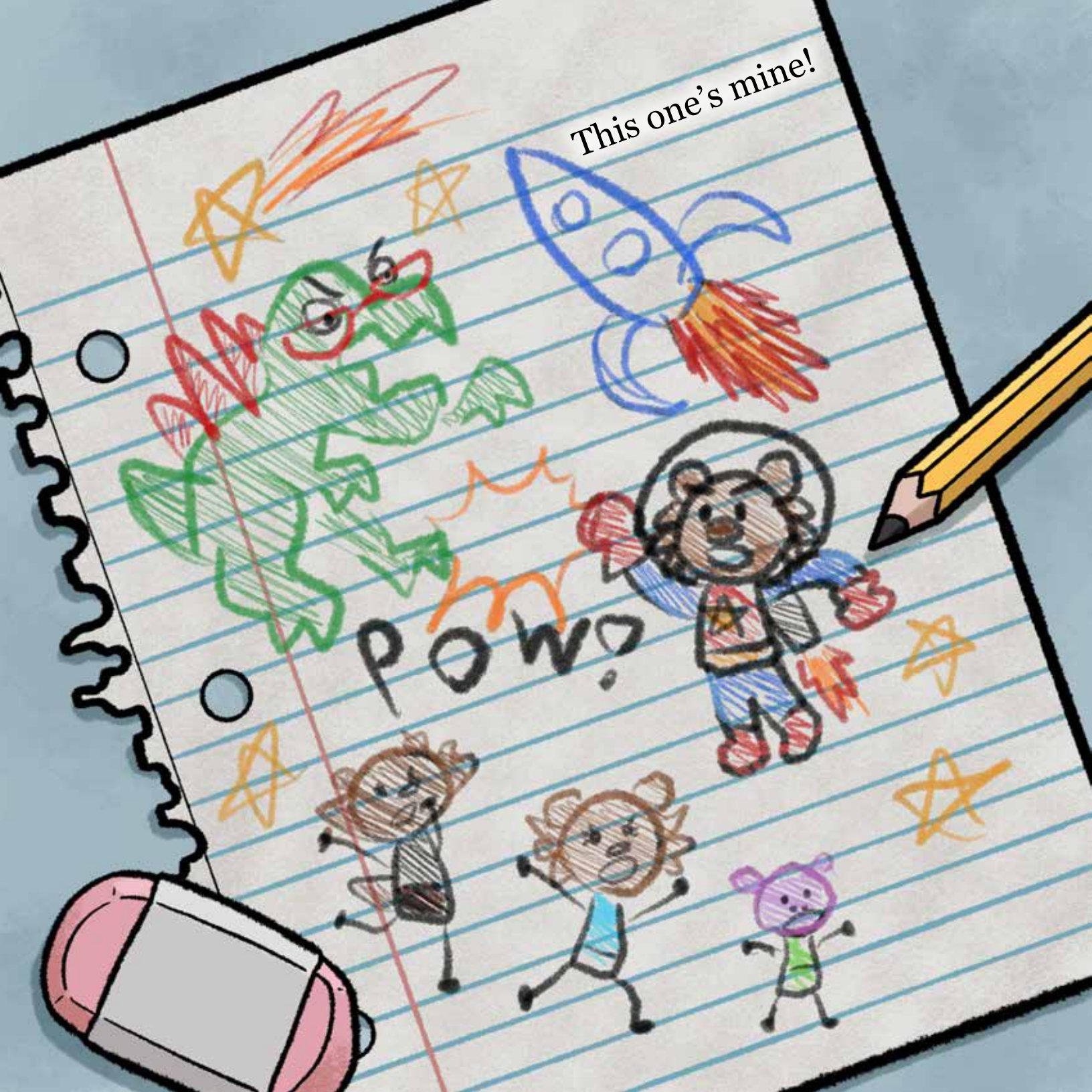
KCC is a college by our school.

There are camps for all ages at KCC,

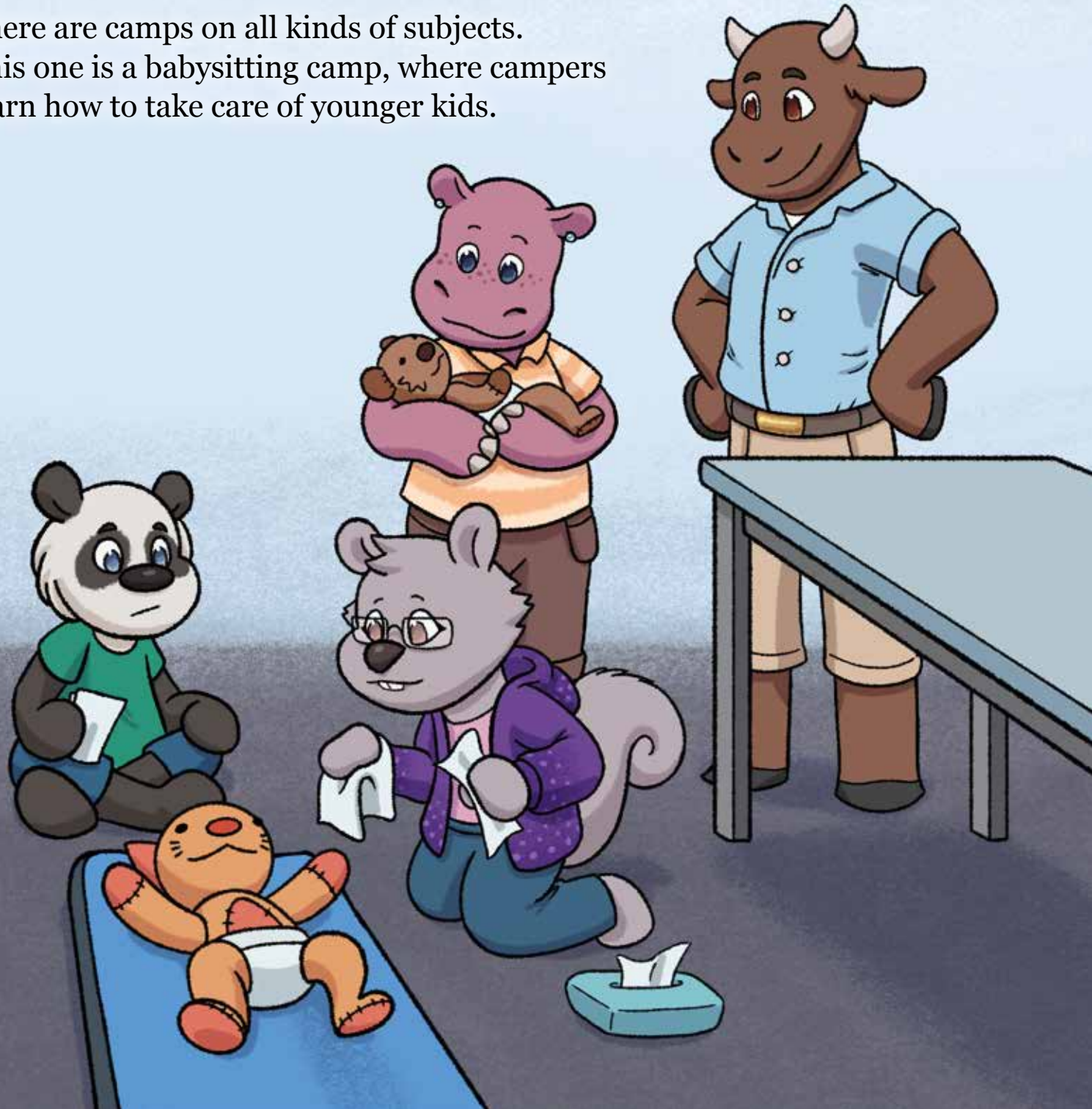


from elementary school kids

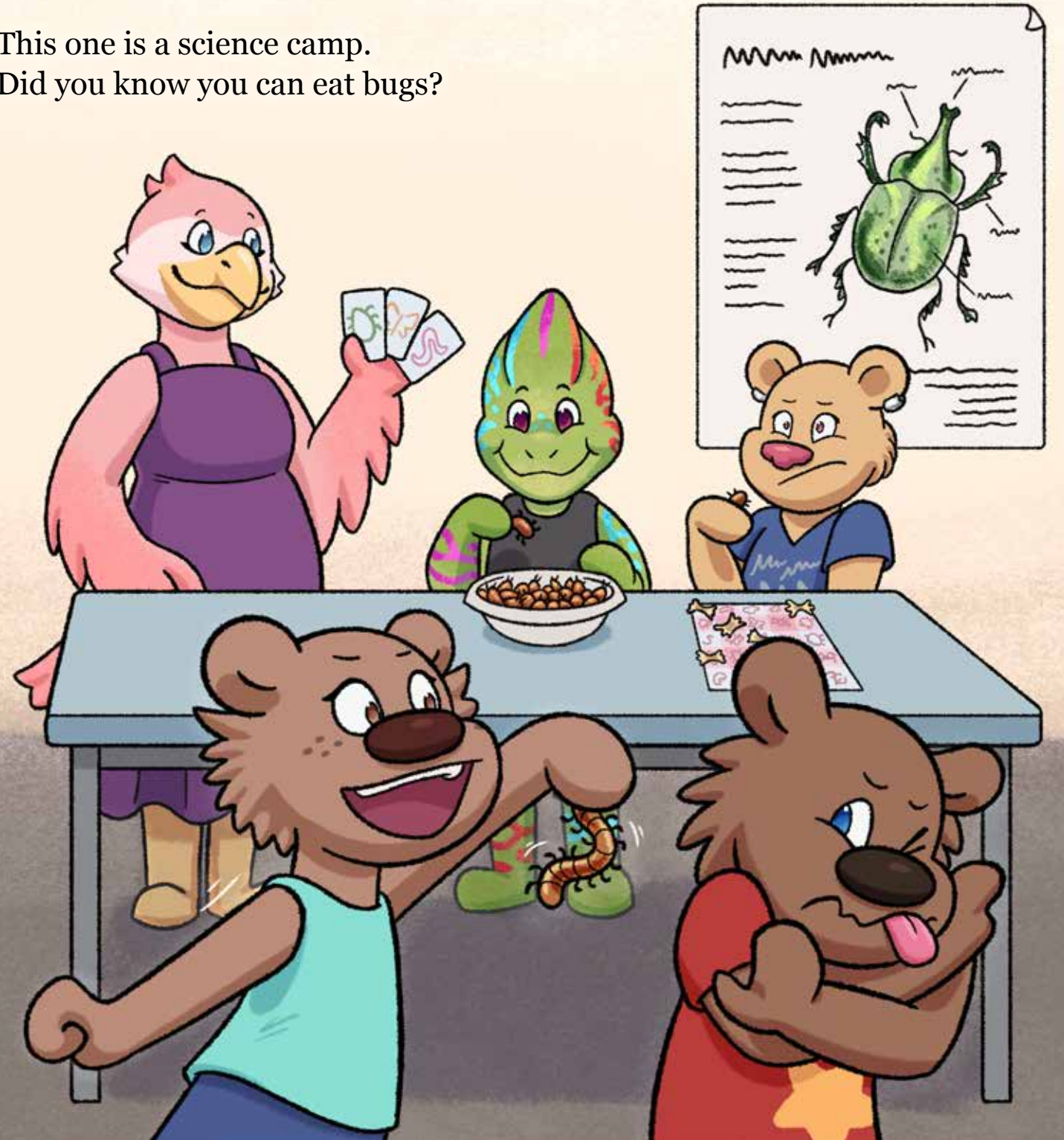
to high school students!

They go all over campus and learn what it's like to be nurses, police officers,

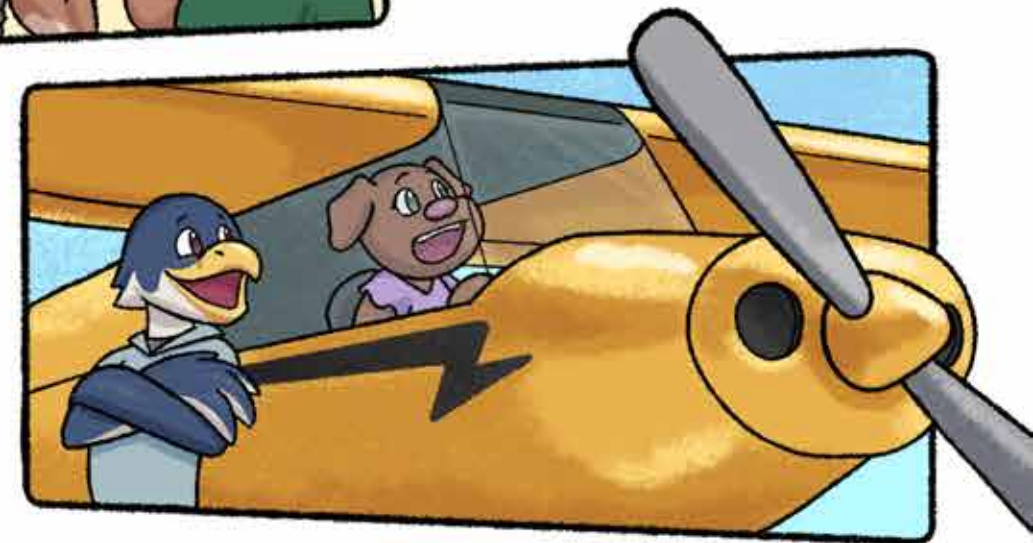


business owners and more!

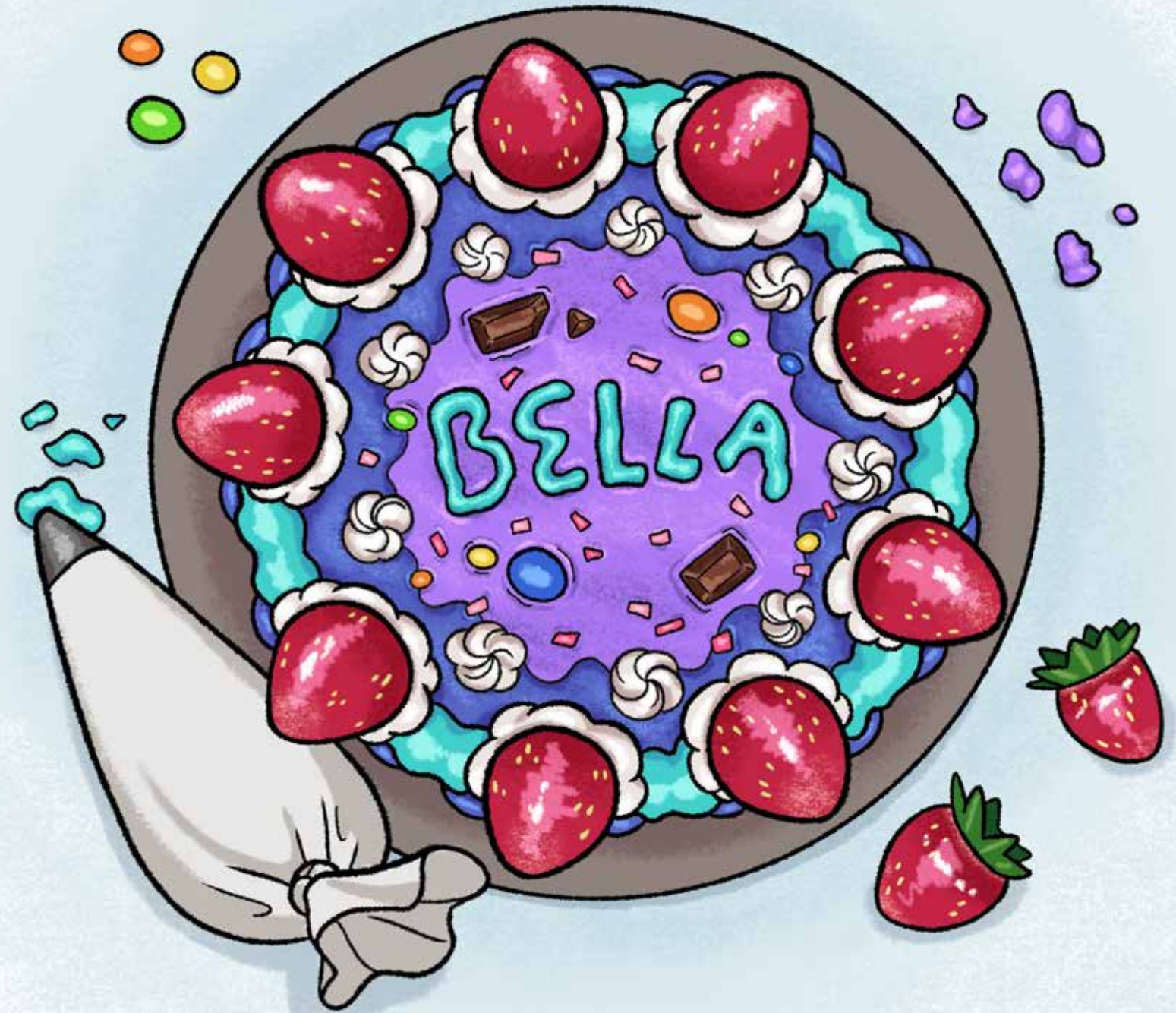




Bella's favorite camp is the cake decorating camp. Kids learn how to decorate cakes, and even get to bring one home!

game camps!

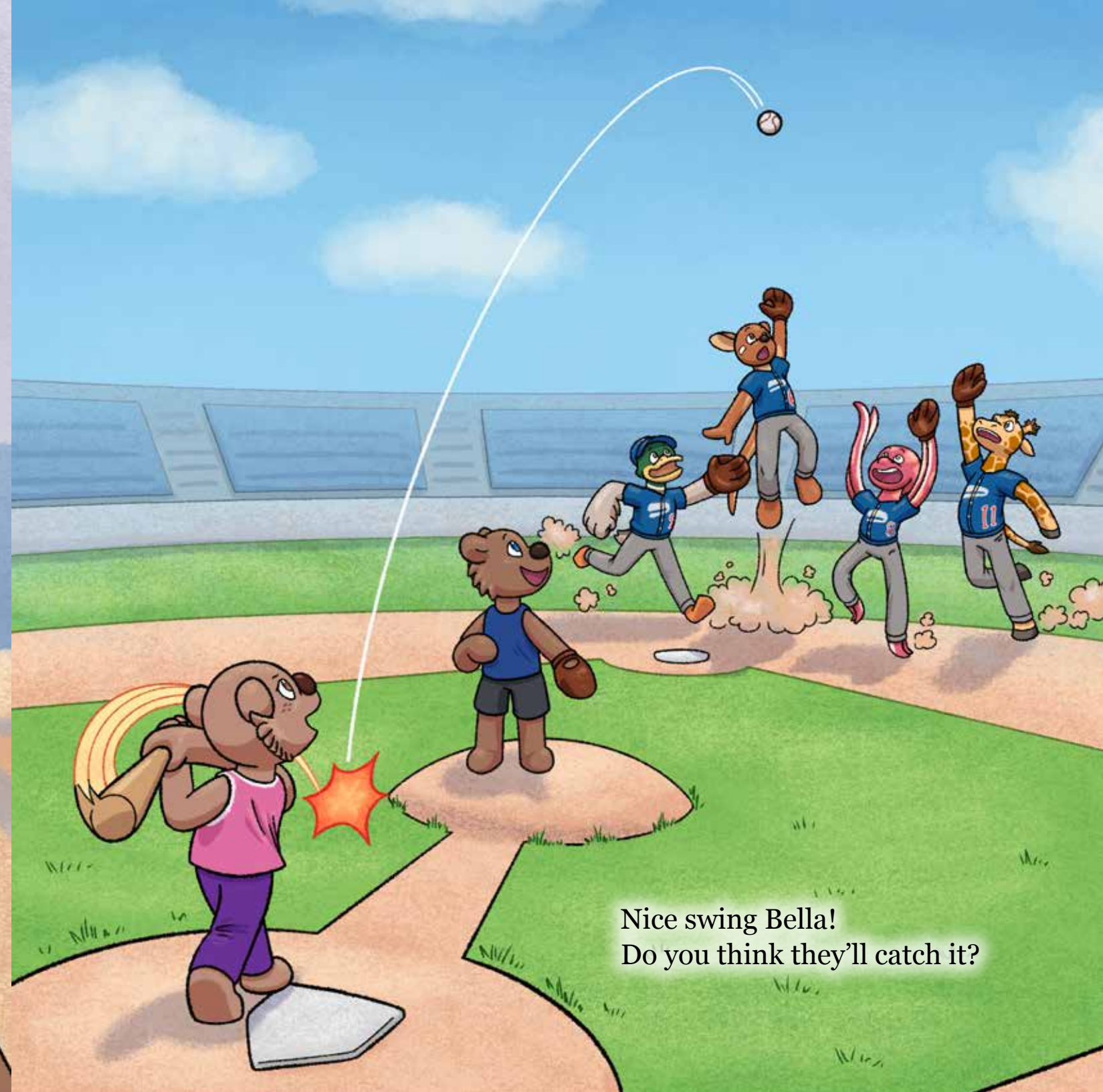
Ask your parents to sign you up today!

I like the video game camps. Campers learn how to make real video games they can play at home!

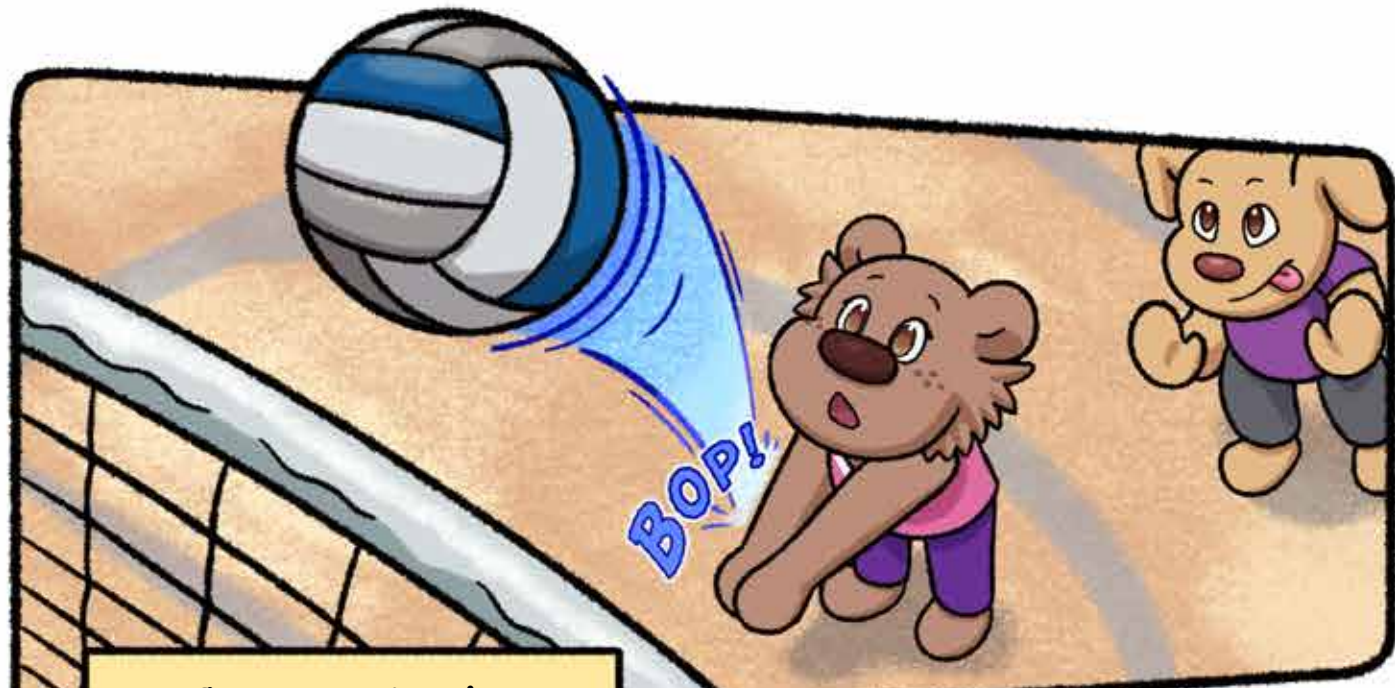


CRT

Here's a poem I wrote about bowling camp!

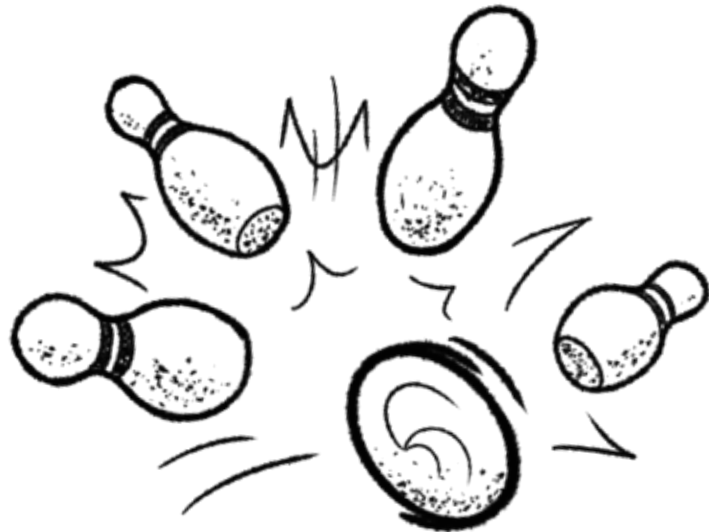
BOWLING CAMP

We won first place!

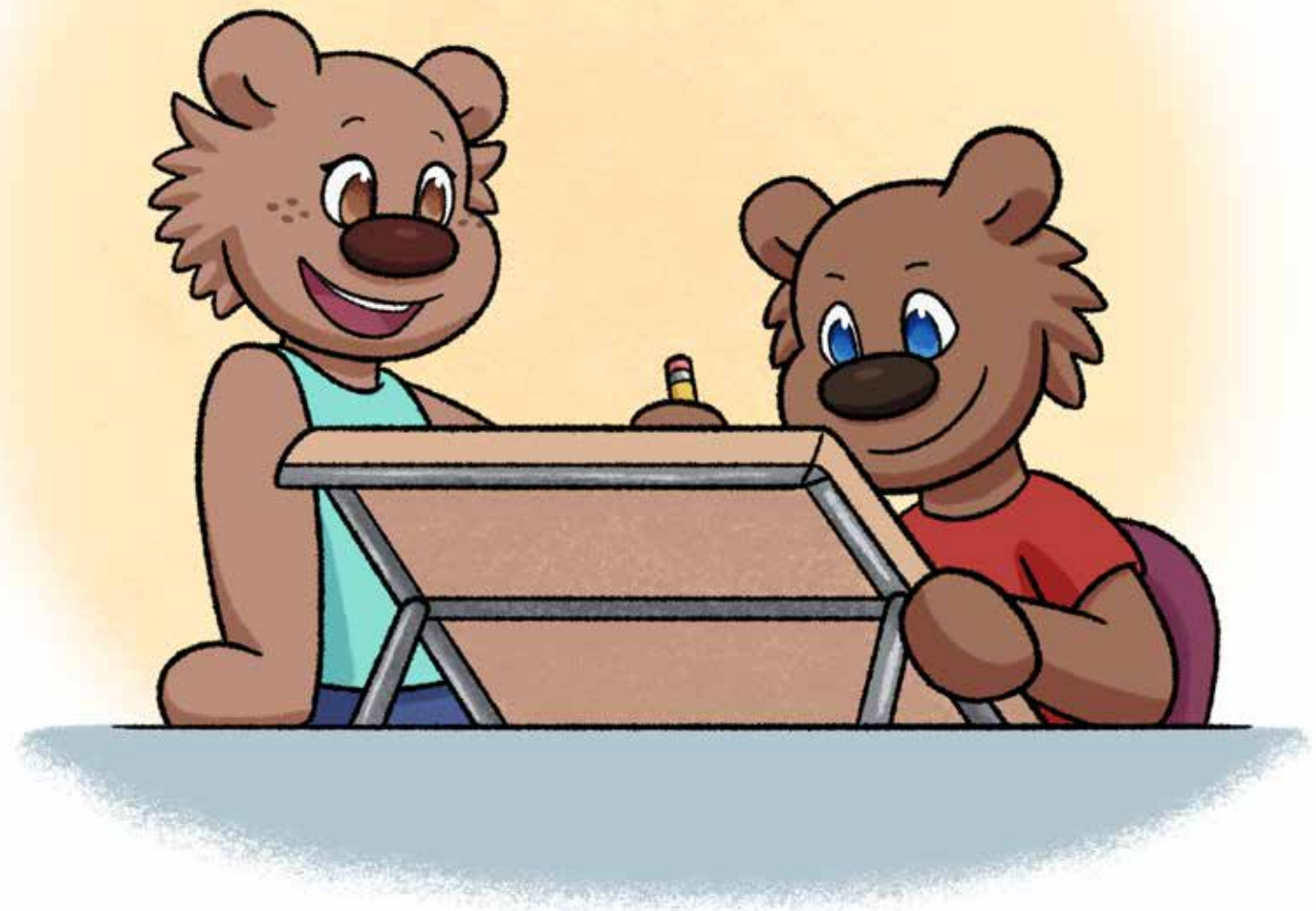
