### Dual Enrollment

(You must be at least 17 to register)

Meet with your **high school counselor**.

Obtain a **NURS 105** new yellow Dual Enrollment packet from your counselor

Submit an online Dual Enrollment Application at [kellogg.edu/apply](http://kellogg.edu/apply)

Complete KCC's **Next-Gen ACCUPLACER®** Reading assessment test or submit **ACT, PSAT / SAT** scores. *Required reading scores: Next-Gen ACCUPLACER® 240 or greater, ACT 14 or greater, PSAT / SAT 22 or greater*

**Submit completed NURS 105 Dual Enrollment packet** (all signatures are required) to the nearest KCC campus or submit completed NURS 105 dual enrollment packets to Angela Green, CNA Coordinator, Faculty.

**Show residency**, i.e. provide driver's license or proof of address.

**Register** for NURS 105 in person at any KCC campus and get a student ID.

**Purchase** text book from the KCC Bookstore (located in the Lane-Thomas Building) before your first class.
